Autism Awareness seminar 28 March 2011

School of Education, QUB

- With a rise in prevalence of Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) to nearly 1:100 it is highly likely that staff in Health, Education, and Social Care professions will meet individuals diagnosed with ASD, even if they are not specialising in the area.
- This seminar is aimed at students about to qualify and staff already in Health, Education, and Social Care professions who are non-specialists in ASD.
- We will provide the audience with an awareness and knowledge of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), including Aspergers Syndrome.
